



Mr. Harold Mayfield

August 14, 1947 - July 3, 2019

Harold Mayfield, Sr. passed away peacefully, surrounded by his loving wife and children, in Alpharetta, Georgia on July 3, 2019 at the age of 71.

Harold is survived by his wife, Rhoda; his six children: Harold, Jr., Nichelle, Khari, Kaloma, Noni, and Kobi; Daughters-in-Law: Amanda, Jenifer, Trisha, Sarah and Stephanie, ten grandchildren: Jacinda, Helena, Kali, Kaloma, Jr., Khari, Jr., Kendall, Kai, Kyla, Khloe and Kody, Sisters-in-Law: Geneva Mayfield, Scharlene Bivens and Diane Bivens, his sister Pam Young and many other relatives. Over twelve years, the couple welcomed six children into their home and Harold set about on teaching them how to be honorable, respectful and strong-minded individuals. His children remember him as a kind, gentle, patient, driven, and funny as can be father who encouraged them to pursue their goals.

Harold was an avid drum corps enthusiast, having marched with the Privateers, St. Rocco's, and the NY Skyliners. Harold played multiple instruments including the bass baritone and the contrabass and loved attending drum corps shows with his family and friends every summer. He was a generous and witty individual who loved traveling, playing golf, attending concerts and reminiscing with his friends. Harold coached his children's soccer teams and cherished the memories that they created together. He was a devoted husband, father and grandfather who was passionate about spending time with his wife, children and grandchildren.

Harold enjoyed a very successful career in pharmaceutical sales and management for over 30 years beginning with Bayer AG and other major companies. He was offered an

opportunity to relocate his family to Atlanta, GA in 1993 and he accepted the challenge to manage the east coast as the regional sales manager for ZLB. Harold retired in 2015 after enjoying a successful career.
