Outside of work, Paula was a dedicated volunteer, working many years with Roswell United Methodist Church's Job Networking Ministry and as a co-leader of GriefShare. Paula also gave many hours to Drake House in Roswell, as well as to Must Ministry. She is preceded in death by her parents and by her first husband, John Pope. She is survived by her husband Bob Hulse, sisters Lisa (Jim) Shields and Beth (Aaron) Loney, nephew Brandon Shields and nieces Jenna Hellekson and Sarah Loney, as well as numerous great nieces and nephews.
