



Mrs. Stephanie Callaway

June 22, 1967 - February 14, 2020

On Friday February 14, 2020, Stephanie Helen Paschak Callaway passed away at home in Alpharetta Georgia at age 52, after a two and half year courageous battle against cancer. She passed peacefully surrounded by her family and felt the love and support from all the family and friends that rallied around Stephe during her fight.

Stephanie grew up in Pasadena MD then went to college at James Madison University in Harrisonburg VA where she was a member of the Zeta Tau Alpha sorority. After college she started her career with Roadnet Technologies in Baltimore MD, a division of UPS. She then spent the next 27 years with UPS rising to the role of Vice President of Marketing. Due to her hard work and dedication, UPS named a conference room in her honor at UPS Headquarters in Atlanta GA. They were able to share this token of gratitude with Stephanie before she passed away.

Stephanie is survived by her husband, Michael Shawn Callaway, son Chase Duval Callaway, parents William Paschak Jr. and Nancy Cassard Paschak, brother William Alec Paschak, sister in law Denise Callaway, nieces Mallory Hash and Lindsay Hash, as well as a host of cousins and other extended family members that cared for her deeply.

Stephanie is also survived by friends from all facets of her life; her infectious personality, empathetic, caring, and supportive nature touched many people throughout her life. She stayed in close contact with childhood friends, high school friends, college and ZTA friends, friends from her neighborhood and UPS friends. It is a testament to how loved Stephanie was that all those people were supporting her and praying for her up until her last breath.

A Memorial service will be held at 3pm on Saturday, February 29, 2020 at St Aidan's Episcopal Church at 13560 Cogburn Road, Milton GA 30004.
