Adrena Delauder Losh, 61, of Roswell, GA passed away Saturday, December 7th at Northside Hospital in Atlanta with her family by her side. Adrena was born on March 13, 1958 in Grafton, WV. She attended Morgantown High School and West Virginia University.

Adrena married her high school sweetheart, William Gregory Losh, in 1981. The couple lived in West Virginia, Ohio, Indiana, and Maine before settling in Roswell, GA in 1999. As a young adult, Adrena worked as an accountant, but her true life's work began with the birth of her first child in 1988. Adrena would go on to homeschool her four children whom she loved deeply. 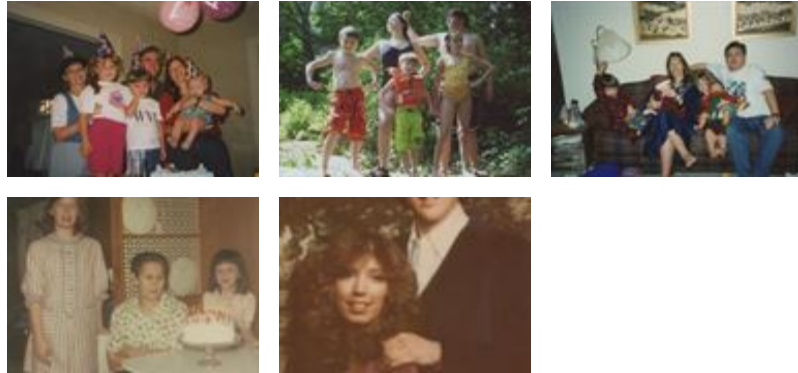

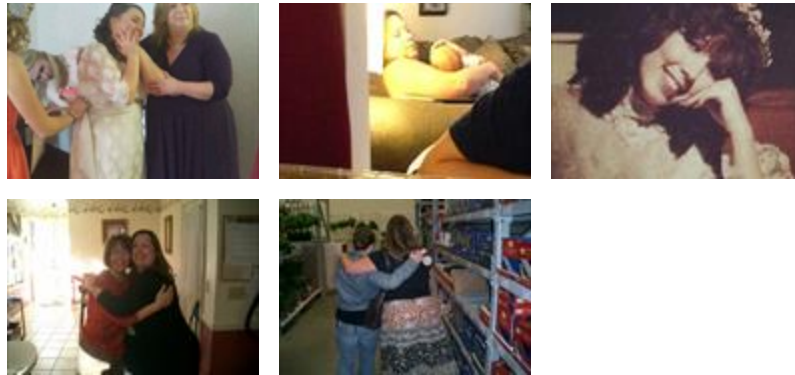
