Alexander Karl Doyle went to be with the Lord at the age of 21 on December 22nd after a nearly four-year battle with Osteosarcoma. and determination and especially his faith and trust in God throughout an extremely difficult and exhausting fight with cancer. He was secure in the love that Jesus has for him and was not afraid to go home to be with the Lord and this amazing faith touched many right up until his time with us in this life was over.
