Anargyros “Cole” Mantas, 26, suddenly and tragically passed away on December 18, 2025. Cole, as he was known to friends, was born in the Boston, Massachusetts area on October 21, 1999 to Patricia Mantas Lico and Nicholas Mantas. Cole was currently residing and working in Athens, Georgia.

Cole attended Cambridge High School. He received his associates degree from Bergen College in New Jersey and continued his studies at UMass - Amherst in Massachusetts.
