My prayer is that God will strengthen, comfort, and guide you. He will never leave you nor forsake you. Lean and depend on Him.

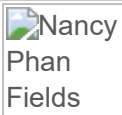

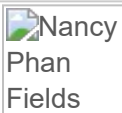

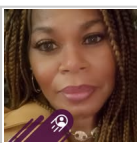
