



Mr. Angelo Thomas Mallis

Angelo T. Mallis, age 92, of Gainesville, GA (formerly of Ann Arbor, MI) passed away peacefully at home on April 25, 2020. Originally born in Greece, he immigrated to the U.S. and lived in Ann Arbor, MI for 27 years, where he and his wife owned and operated several restaurants, the last two being Mallis' Coffee Cup and Mallis' Steak-Out. He was a member of St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church in Ann Arbor. They moved to Roswell, GA and owned and operated a pizza business, Pizza by Nitsa, for 14 years. He was a member of Holy Transfiguration Greek Orthodox Church in Marietta, GA. Angelo was a loving father and grandfather. He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Tom and Dianna Mallis of Gainesville; daughters and sons-in-law, Ann and Matt Zakreski of Woodstock and Nancy and William A. Porter of Cumming; and grandchildren Tommy, Jacob and Hesper Mallis, Nick and Lauren Zakreski, and Lucas and Nia Porter. Angelo is preceded in death by his wife, Urania (Nitsa) Mallis, his parents, Thomas and Efthimia Karamalis, and his brother, Stelios Karamalis.
