



## Mrs. Anna-Louise Baxter

Alpharetta, GA - Anna-Louise Baxter, 89, died on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at Arbor Terrace Crabapple Assisted Living, after a lengthy battle with Alzheimer's Disease and diminished capacity.
