Emily Anne Burgess, 65, of Alpharetta, died on Feb. 10, 2010. 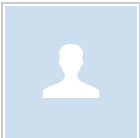

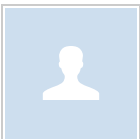

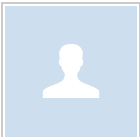
