Anne Malcom Ledford died peacefully on Sunday, November 19, 2017. She was 89. Anne was born on July 15, 1928 in Walton County, Georgia, to Edward and Mary Dickinson Malcom. She graduated from Monroe High School in 1945, and she continued her education, graduating from the University of Georgia.

Anne married Frederic R. Ledford on August 7, 1960 at Stone Mountain First Baptist Church. Their daughter, Mary Cynthia Ledford, was born in 1963.
