



Mr. B.C. (Sandy) Sanderson Sr.

April 12, 1925 - August 21, 2016

Bradford C Sanderson Sr, of Alpharetta died at the age of 91 on Sunday August 21, 2016. Known as Sandy he was born in Fall River, Massachusetts on April 12, 1925. Upon graduation from high school he became part of the "Greatest Generation" serving in the United States Navy during World War II. After the war he attended and graduated from North Georgia College where he also played on the baseball team. He began his career in education at Lumpkin County High School and later retired from the Fulton County School System having served as a science teacher, coach and guidance counselor at Milton High School from 1954-1980. A longtime resident of Alpharetta he was a member of the First United Methodist Church and later Mt Pisgah United Methodist. An active member of the American Legion Post 201 he continued to serve his country through various volunteer activities. He is survived by sons and daughters in law Brad Sanderson Jr (Judy), Fred Sanderson (Carey), Johnny Jackson (LaDonna) and step-daughter Dawn Bray (Robby). Brother: Carl Sanderson.
