



## Mrs. Barbara A. Jagrowski

Barbara Anne Jagrowski (nee Flannery), born in New York City on September 9, 1933, passed away peacefully on March 23, 2025, in Roswell, Georgia. She lived a full and vibrant life loving God by loving others as a dedicated Air Force wife, a steadfast, loving mother to her children, and a volunteer for countless charitable organizations.

On June 8, 1957, Barbara married her beloved husband, Gerald Leon Jagrowski, an Air Force Officer. Their military orders took them on a 30-year journey across Georgia, Florida, Texas, Vermont, Spain, California, New York, Colorado, Virginia, Denmark, and Ohio.
