



## Mr. Bernard V. Roth

October 25, 1920 - October 8, 2015

ROTH – On October 8, 2015, Mr. Bernard Valentine Roth of Roswell, at age 94, passed away with family present. During WWII, he proudly served his country in the Army and was stationed in the Philippines. For years afterwards, he was a successful businessman, having started his own company, and was later joined by his sons Donald and Richard. He will always be remembered as “the greatest.”
