



## Betty E. Scott

June 1, 1925 - January 6, 2014

Betty Endres Scott, died peacefully Monday, January 6, 2014 in Roswell, Georgia surrounded by family members. She was the wife of Gerald L. Scott (64 years) and the mother of one son and one daughter.

She was born June 1, 1925 in Kansas City, Missouri, the daughter of William Payne and Lora Lenora Endres, both deceased. She grew up in the Kansas City area. In 1949 she met and married Gerald, marriage later solemnized in the Idaho Falls, Id. Temple. Shortly following their marriage they moved to the Washington, D.C. area where her son was born. After several years in the area they moved back to Kansas City, where their daughter was born. The family spent many wonderful years there. In 1965 the family moved to Cincinnati, Ohio. Work took the family to Syracuse, NY in 1969. The next move brought them to the Atlanta area in 1973 where they have resided since that time.
