Bruce Lewis Benson, 73 of Roswell, died unexpectedly on April 10, 2008. He was born in Binghamton, NY in 1934 to Harry E. and Margaret Wood Benson. He was predeceased by his loving wife, Patricia A. Benson. Bruce worked for IBM for 30 years beginning his career in Endicott, NY working in both Lexington, KY and Westchester County, NY before retiring to Georgia in 1994. Bruce's father owned Benson's Market on Chenango Street in Binghamton for many years. Bruce was a graduate of Broome Community college in Binghamton and served in the US Army playing trumpet in the Army band. He was an active member of Northbrook United Methodist Church in Roswell, where he was a member of the choir and was involved in many community outreach activities. Bruce was also a volunteer at North Fulton Regional Hospital for many years. Bruce loved music and played the trumpet in the New Horizons Band of Roswell and was a member of the jazz ensemble and swing bands which delighted people at their various concert events. Bruce is survived by his son, David B. Benson of Roswell and daughter Donna L. Geuser, her husband and two grandsons, of Farmington, CT.
