



## Mr. Carlton Edmond Skinner

March 3, 1949 - May 14, 2019

On March 14, 1949, Carlton Edmond Skinner was born in Roswell, GA to the parents of Julian Princeton Skinner (father) and Ethel Louise Grogan (mother). Carlton and Carolyn Frances Sims were united in marriage on March 26, 2004. Carolyn survives his untimely death (May 14, 2019) and resides at their Cumming, Georgia home.

Carlton attended Roswell High School and graduated in 1967. Shortly after high school, Carlton attended Basic Training for the United States Army at Fort Dixon, New Jersey. After his service in the United States Army (1975), he went on to serve the City of Atlanta Water Works Department for 37 years as a Water Purification Specialist. Although Carlton retired after his illustrious career, he became restless. He then went back to work for 17 years lending his professional skills to City of Gwinnett Water Department. Carlton finally retired from the City of Gwinnett, and took full advantage of his time fishing, deer hunting, traveling with his wife, Carolyn to national parks and nature trails. He was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed nature and being the consummate prankster.

Carlton's family grieves his loss and includes his brother, Dudley Skinner, oldest brother Julian Douglas Skinner (preceded in death).
