



## Caroline Moore

January 12, 1911 - November 30, 2007

MOORE-Mrs. Caroline H. Moore, 96, died on November 30, 2007. She had been a resident of Jackson, Mississippi from 1960 until 2005, when she went to Atlanta to live with her son and his wife. Mrs. Moore was born on January 12, 1911, in Union Springs, Alabama, to William R. and Alice Evans (Eva) Trawick Harrison, the third of three children. Her family was devoted to education. Mr. Harrison later became the long-time superintendent of schools in Montgomery County, Alabama. Her two brothers were both college teachers: Charles T. Harrison, chairman of the Department of English at the University of the South at Sewanee Tennessee, and M. Leigh Harrison, Dean of the Law School at the University of Alabama. Mrs. Moore graduated from Randolph-Macon Women's College (A.B. in French) in 1932, and received an M.A. (in English) from Radcliffe College in 1942. In 1938 she married R. Edgar Moore. Dr. Moore, who was chair of the Department of Education at Millsaps College from 1960 until 1972, died in 1980. Mrs. Moore held various editorial and bookstore jobs and taught English at the high school and collegiate level during their marriage. She was acquisitions librarian and faculty member at Millsaps College when she retired in 1977. Mrs. Moore is survived by a son, Charles H. Moore, and his wife, Patricia A. Hoban-Moore, of Atlanta, Georgia; a daughter, Carol Cox, and her husband, Fletcher Cox, of Tougaloo, Mississippi; a grandson, Edward C. Moore, and his wife, Maureen Wishkowski, of Birmingham, Alabama; a granddaughter, Catherine Lee, and her husband, Garrad Lee, of Boulder, Colorado; a niece, Barbara Ann Smith,

and her husband, Rev. Harwood Smith, of Boone, North Carolina; a nephew, Robert Harrison, and his wife, Carolyn Harrison, of Danville, Virginia; and several grandnieces, grandnephews, great-grandnieces, and great-grandnephews.
