



Mrs. Catherine Booth Morris

December 5, 1954 - March 26, 2017

After an eight month courageous battle with cancer, Catherine Booth Morris went to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 26, 2017 in Atlanta, Georgia at the age of 62. She leaves behind her loving husband, Steve Morris; her sons, Andrew and Timothy Morris; her daughter, Meghan Gavrilas; and her granddaughters, Emery and Piper.

Catherine was born on December 5, 1954 in Detroit, Michigan to Arthur D. Booth, Jr. and Ellen Reno Booth. She grew up in a large family with two sisters and one brother. Her family relocated to Port Huron, Michigan in her early years and then to Clearwater, Florida while she was in high school. She graduated from Clearwater High School in 1973.

In 1976, she married her husband in Atlanta. After moving to Clearwater in 1979, they welcomed their first born, Andrew, into the world. They moved to Orlando in 1980 where their second child, Meghan, was born in 1981 and third child, Timothy, in 1982. Once again, Steve's career moved the family to Ocala in 1989 and finally to Roswell, Georgia in 1998 where Catherine lived her remaining years.

Catherine was a vibrant, happy person who could lift anyone's spirit and light up any room she walked into. She excelled at making everyone around her feel better for having been in her presence.

Perhaps best known as a very devoted mother and wife, she absolutely lived for her family. To her, there was nothing more important in life than her family. She loved being near the water and the beach. Catherine enjoyed the simple

things in life like baking cookies for her family, watching the Gators with her husband and sons during college football season, and meeting for a girl's shopping trip with her daughter and granddaughter. She was each of her children's best friend and confidant and also her granddaughter's favorite playmate. There's no doubt she was the best mother anyone could ask for and she will be missed every day, but she will live on in the hearts of her loved ones forever.

Catherine's funeral will be held on Wednesday, March 29th at Saint Peter Chanel Catholic Church in Roswell, Georgia at 2 p.m. All are welcome
