Charles A. Wright, Sr., 79, of Alpharetta, Georgia was called home by our Lord on September 24, 2012, and he was "sittin' on ready." Mr. Wright was born in Sandy Springs, Georgia on November 6, 1932 to Crawford and Sally Wright.

Mr. Wright enlisted in the United States Army in 1951 to serve his country, becoming a decorated Korean War veteran. He married Martha Ann Bell on August 20, 1952; they recently celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary. Together they raised four children.

Mr. Wright was a master craftsman who loved working with his hands. He spent most of his working career in building construction, retiring in 2003; he then spent his remaining years working in the maintenance department at Cumming Nursing Center.
