Charles Evan Heuer, 84, of Canton, Georgia, passed away peacefully on April 11, 2024, after a brave battle with Dementia and Parkinson's.

Charles was born on July 31, 1939, to Charles and Irene Heuer in Chicago, Illinois. He graduated from The Illinois Institute of Technology, with a degree in engineering.
