Charles "Bud" Arthur Koch, Jr., age 92, passed on August 30, 2013. Bud is survived by his wife Margaret, his two sons Charles Koch III of Napa, CA and Christopher Koch Sr. of Roswell, GA as well as 3 grandchildren.
