He would get frequent complaints about me (unfounded) from one person in particular. While he shook his finger at me as he pretended to scold me after one of this woman's many complaints, he said "when you leave my office, I want you to tell her how pretty her dress is." I said "her dress is ugly but I'll do it for you Charlie." As I left his office, she happened to be walking by. When I told her how pretty her dress was, she looked down at her dress then up at me a couple of times, smiled from ear to ear and said "really, you like it? I said "yes!" From that day on there were no more complaints. She never hassled me again. I will always remember that lesson and Charlie. I thought about him today and decided to look him up only to find his obituary and to find out that he lived not far from where I moved to in Georgia in 1985 when I left Community Development.
