Charles Lamar Pettett, 83, of Marietta, Georgia, passed away October 15, 2018, after a short illness. Charles was born, December 11, 1934, the eldest of three children to the late Hubert and Amanda Pettett. He was a lifetime resident of Cobb County and lived in East Cobb with his wife of 62 years, Betty Mabry Pettett.
