



## Chun-Ming Choy

February 16, 1928 - April 8, 2011

Choy Chun-Ming passed away peacefully at age 83 on April 8, 2011. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather. He is survived by his wife of 46 years, Tse Yin-Lung and his daughter, Agnes Ho. Mr. Choy is most well known for his publication of a Chinese dictionary translating between Mandarin and a local dialect of the Chinese language. This dictionary is a culmination of his 35 year career at Chinese University of Hong Kong where he served as a research assistant and an instructor. Since retiring in Alpharetta, he has been an active member of the Alpharetta Adult Activity Center. He taught Tai-Chi class three times a week and was a volunteer for 10 years. A memorial service will be held at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church at 10:00 a.m. on April 12, 2011.
