May 24, 1933 - February 8, 2017

Al died at his home in Milton, GA February 8th, 2017 at age 83. He was born in Dayton, OH May 24, 1933 to James Otis and Mildred Sharp Beckham. Moving to Atlanta as a young boy, Al enjoyed a large, loving family and many lifelong friends. Al graduated from Northside High School where he was Commander of JROTC and quarterback of the football team. He was a walk-on at the University of GA under Wally Butts. Al was a “Wally’s Boy” and a “Buckhead Boy.” He could liven up any party or gathering of friends and family with imitations of Gen. Patton and Winston Churchill. Al was a charter member of Northside Drive Baptist Church in Atlanta. He coached young boys in football, baseball, golf, and Sunday school. Fritz Orr camp on West Paces Ferry was a favorite place for some of his coaching. Al was a long time sales rep. for A.G. Spalding Sporting Goods until the love of golf drew him to teach the basics of the game to others. Golf was his game. His family presented him with his treasured “Green Jacket” which meant more to him than his hole-in-one. Preceding him in death were his infant daughter, Carol Lynn Beckham; brothers James, Winfield, Charles and Curtis Beckham; sisters LaVonne Freeman, Betty Almeida, Elaine Smith and his beloved shelties. Survivors cherishing his memory are his wife of 55 years, Catherine (Connie) Beckham, son, Clarence Albert (Cal) Beckham and his wife, Urszula Maligranda; his brother Gordon Beckham (Joan) of Statham, GA and many loving and loved nieces and nephews. At the time of Al’s death, he was a member of Alpharetta First Baptist Church. The church ministered to his spiritual care and Agape
