

## Clay Young

June 9, 1947 - February 3, 2014

Clay Young, dedicated and beloved father, husband, and friend lost his battle with lung cancer on February 3rd, 2014. He was born on June 9th, 1947 in Roswell, Georgia. Clay Young made his way through life how he wanted to, establishing himself as a world-traveling professional racecar driver, builder, carpenter, businessman, and musician. Determined not to work for “the man,” Clay ran his own racing operations, later becoming the sole proprietor of Wanda’s Auto Towing Service. Clay Young was a two-time IMSA road-race champion, whose name is listed on the wall of fame at Daytona USA. His accomplishments include racing at various venues all over the world, including the Australian Thunderdome, Venezuela, Canada, and all across the continental United States. Clay always strived for perfection, and found success in nearly all of his endeavors. He was a role model to all those around him, including crewmembers, family, and friends, some of whom even considered him liken to a second father. He is preceded in death by: his mother Georgia Emma Angeline Young, father Chester Clay Young, sisters Sarah Kent and Joyce Huggins of Roswell, Ga.; brother Billy Young, and sister Sue Cook of Marietta, Ga. 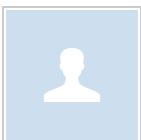
