June 20, 1913 - March 13, 2008

Mrs. Cleda Muriel Morgan, surrounded by her family and friends at home in Crabapple, passed to her Lord on March 13, 2008. Born on June 20, 1913 to Minnie and Rev. R.O. Clements in Clay City, IL, she was the second of three daughters. Sisters, Mrs. Eleanor A. Howe and Ms. Maxine Clements preceded her in death. She married John W. Morgan on Sept. 20, 1936 in her parent's Mt. Vernon, IL home in a service performed by her father. John was the son of Joseph Elmer and Roxie Belle Morgan of Dubois, IL and older brother of Mrs. Hazel Gaissert. Muriel and John's first child, John R. "Chip" Morgan, was born Dec. 4, 1940 while they lived in Mount Vernon, IL. After moving to Atlanta, GA in 1943, their daughter Susan Eleanor was born on July 19, 1946.
