Mr. Clyde Cotton Price, Jr. of 371 Canton Street, Alpharetta, Georgia quietly passed away on Thursday, June 18, 2015. Mr. Price had been suffering from the degenerative challenges of Parkinson's disease.

Mr. Price is preceded in death by his parents Clyde Cotton Price, Sr. and Mary Jane Hook Price. He is survived by his brother Burt Lee Price and sister in law Pam Price and his nephews of Noah and Luke Price of Apex, NC; his cousins Brenda H. Futch of Woodstock and Jere Hook of Canton.

Clyde was born in Atlanta Georgia. He attended E.L. Connelly Elementary School, Brown High School in Atlanta and graduated from Lakeshore High School in College Park. He received two undergraduate degrees from Georgia State University in Journalism and Ancient Languages. He received a Masters of Divinity from Atlanta School of Biblical Studies.

He lived his entire life in the greater Atlanta area including Red Oak, Buckhead, Grant Park and Alpharetta.

Clyde was a phenomenal Bible Scholar and lover of books. At the age of six

he nearly died from an acute case of appendicitis. After that event, he viewed his life as living on borrowed time.

He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and was loved for his devotion to scripture and to the Lord. He was a man of great faith who taught many the value of that prized characteristic. He was ordained to the office of Priest in the Aaronic Priesthood.
