January 5, 1960 - May 21, 2011

Cole Christopher (Ty) Kennedy, 51, of Roswell, died of cancer May 21, 2011 at home surrounded by his family. Ty was born in Hartford, CT on January 5, 1960 to loving parents Robert T. and Dorothy Callahan Kennedy, who predeceased him. He attended Christ the King School, St. Pius High School and graduated from Georgia Southern College. His determination in Scouts culminated in his achievement of the rank of Eagle Scout. Ty was passionate about his 30 years of service with Brooks Brothers and like his father, was a man of great sartorial splendor.
