was open, personable, and engaging. He brought laughter and joy to many. He made a point to embarrass his children regularly, but always expressed his strong desire to be the best father he could be. Dale was actively involved in the interests and activities of his children, sacrificing his time to be a coach and a vocal fan. He had a special relationship with his granddaughter, Whitney, who put a smile on his face when she called him "Ah-daddy." It was clear to everyone how loving and devoted he was to all family and friends. Dale was an avid Michigan State fan, always supporting his Spartans with robust enthusiasm. 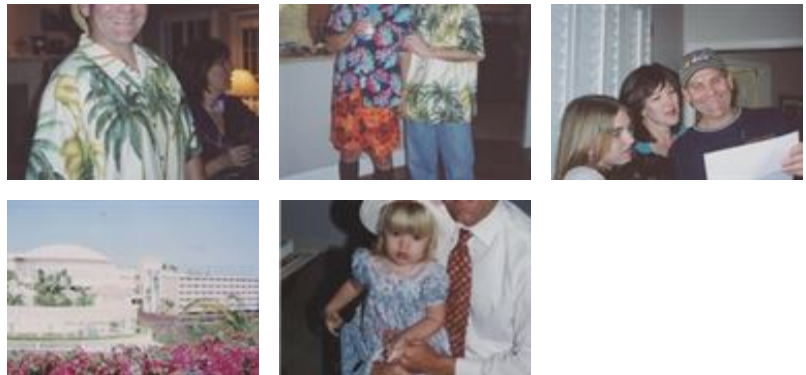
