Daniel John Fadgen, Jr., born December 11, 1950 in Miami, FL, passed away October 7, 2011 after an extended, courageous battle with pulmonary fibrosis. He is survived by his wife Jane Dyer Fadgen, daughter Tamara Fadgen Pirkle, son-in-law Stephen Pirkle, step-daughter Karen Bennett Mathis, son-in-law Neil Mathis, 3 grandchildren Andrew Mathis, Claire Mathis and Jacob Mathis, niece Stacie Fernandez Allen and nephew Ryan Fernandez. He was preceded in death by his parents Daniel John Fadgen, Sr. and Lucile Brogdon Fadgen and his sister Patricia Fadgen Fernandez. A graduate of Miami Senior High School and The University of Florida, Mr. Fadgen voluntarily joined the Army and served two tours in Vietnam. He was honorably discharged as a Specialist, 1st Cavalry Division. Mr. Fadgen worked in the pharmaceutical industry for his entire career, most recently as Senior Product Manager over pharmaceutical waste disposition in hospitals for Stericycle, Inc. He was an active member of Alpharetta First United Methodist Church and was in attendance almost every Sunday until about a month before he died.
