He loved to plant Pam’s favorite flowers all over their yard, and his back porch is one of the most peaceful places on earth. He loved the Braves and the Bulldogs, and it should bring a smile to the face of any Georgia fan to know that the 2021 season surely was for Darrell.

He was a gifted businessman, but more importantly, he was kind. He would say, “It’s all about relationships,” and he truly lived that way in all areas of his life. He took time to get to know people. Darrell mentored so many and had a special ability to really see the people around him - in so many big and small ways, he loved to care generously and deeply for people.
