David Edwards won his 12 year battle with cancer by walking away on October 14, 2017.

Dave was born on April 17, 1959 in Syracuse, NY and spent his childhood in Henrietta, NY. He attended college at Southwest Missouri State in Springfield, MO. He worked at Johnson Controls for the past 22 years as Lighting Design Engineer.

Dave loved gardening, ultimate Frisbee and playing golf with his pals from the neighborhood. He particularly loved playing tennis with his daughter, Kelly. He was at his best during those matches.

Dave was preceded in death by his loving mother, Barbara Edwards of Rotonda West, FL.
