



David Lee Hilder

Mr. David L. Hilder, age 86, of Cumming, died May 25, 2012. Born in Clifton, NJ, he served in the Army Air Corps as a pilot during WWII, and graduated from Muhlenberg College (Allentown, PA) with a B. S. in Physics in 1949. He was general manager of the Merrimack Valley Works in Massachusetts, and served on the Boards of Directors of the Merrimack Valley National Bank and the Merrimack Valley United Fund. He was also a member of the Board of Trustees of Bon Secours Hospital and the Board of Trustees of Merrimack College. Mr. Hilder retired as Vice –President, Human Resources and Labor Relations of the Western Electric Company, located at the Guilford Center, Greensboro, NC. In 1998 he moved to Roswell, GA. He was preceded in death by his wife, Lucy Romig Hilder and brother, Frederick Hilder. He is survived by his wife, Laverne Hilder; son, David B. Hilder; daughter, Maryellen Berger and her husband Brent; grandchildren, Jack and Isabelle Hilder, Alex and David Berger and extended family, Wills, Kirby and Hosea families.
