Diana Lynne O'Sullivan, 65, passed away January 31, 2020, at Emory University Hospital after a long-fought battle with complications from Breast Cancer. She was married for 39 years to her loving husband Kevin O'Sullivan and raised their three children in Alpharetta, GA.

Diana was a Registered Nurse with a Bachelor of Science of Nursing from Wagner College in New York. After graduation she started her nursing career at New York University Hospital in Manhattan. She subsequently worked in hospitals all across the U.S. as she moved with her husband for job transfers at such medical facilities as the University of Virginia in Charlottesville, VA; St. Luke's Medical Center in Denver, CO; Wesley Long in Greensboro, NC; Shady Grove in Gaithersburg, MD; Northside in Cumming, GA and most recently North Fulton Hospital in Roswell.

Diana had a passion for cooking and baking. Her house and kitchen were always open to guests and she fed many of her children's friends. A holiday dinner hosted by Diana was always a festive affair full of great food and laughter.
