Doris Campion McKinley was born on November 8, 1928 in Cleveland, Ohio, the eldest child of Lawrence and Dorothy Werner. She had a younger brother also named Larry, who passed away in 2010.

Doris attended St. Aloysius Academy and later went to high school at Ursuline Academy. Doris was an outstanding student at Ursuline and, having excelled in the business classes the school offered, she went on to pursue a career in the business world. Shortly thereafter she met her husband of 42 years, Thomas Campion.

Together Tom and Doris raised seven children in Cleveland, and in 1973 moved for a short time to Oxon Hill, Maryland, where Doris rejoined the workforce employed in the corporate offices of KFC. In 1975, Tom's job took them to Atlanta, Georgia, where Doris continued her employment with KFC. A few years later she was employed by the law firm Alston & Bird where she remained until her retirement. Tom passed away on 10/22/93, and shortly thereafter Doris moved to Clermont, Florida where she was one of the original residents of Kings Ridge. Doris was a frequent attendee of the neighborhood exercise classes and social events and was well known throughout the community. There she was reacquainted with her childhood beau, Bill McKinley. They married in 1998 and moved back to the Atlanta area in 2005, where they established residency at St. George Village in Roswell. Doris lived at St. George until her death on October 2, 2014. She will be greatly missed by Bill, her seven children and 13 grandchildren. Sadly, Doris did not live to

see her first great grandchild who was born three days after her death.
