Dorothy (Dolly) Mary Halligan McCabe, died on September 20, 2021, in Alpharetta, Georgia. She was born in 1930 to Patrick Joseph Halligan and Dora McGoey Halligan in Astoria, Queens, NY. She graduated from the College of Mount Saint Vincent in New York City with a bachelor's degree in Commerce Education and took several classes toward her master's degree. Dolly was a teacher throughout her life.

Dolly was married in New York to John Scott McCabe (Jack) for 62 years (RIP, 2016). During their marriage, Dolly and Jack lived in NY, IL, FL, CA and GA and were fortunate enough to travel to Israel, Ireland, and many US destinations.

Dolly is survived by four children (spouse), John (Mary), Mary Beth (Allen), Ellen (Glen) and Joseph (Cindy), seven grandchildren (Megan, Jake, Catherine, Christina, Patrick, Brian, Eric), first cousin Gerry Ryan, and the children of her beloved, late sister Patricia, Maureen, and Patrick.
