



## Dorothy Jeanine Duncan

August 7, 1933 - February 3, 2024

Dorothy "Jeanine" (Whiddon) Duncan entered her eternal life on February 3, 2024, at the age of 90 years. A blue-eyed baby, born in Cairo, Georgia on August 7, 1933, Jeanine was the youngest of four children born to Offie & Annie Whiddon. Annie died of pneumonia when Jeanine was just 6 years old. It was a loss she felt throughout her life. Her father never remarried.

Austell area. Jeanine was so proud of her three sons, all of which were successful professionals: Dennis became a Lawyer, Dale became a Doctor, & Dana became a Senior Program Analyst. Jeanine was a loving Wife, Mother & Grandmother. She was an excellent cook, cultivated lovely gardens at the family home on Wade Road, and was a beauty with great personal style regarding hair & clothing. Trips to Lake Burton, Panama City Beach, and south Georgia for family visits & reunions, were much anticipated by all. She was much loved by family and friends.

Jeanine is preceded in death by her husband, Herman Willard Duncan; mother, Annie Paul Johnson Whiddon; father, Offie Lee Whiddon; sister, Kathleen Whiddon Johnson; brothers: Bernard Whiddon & Carroll Whiddon.
