GARRISON – Dr. Susan L. Garrison, M.D., FACOG, age 45 of Roswell, died February 18, 2011. Dr. Garrison graduated from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York, in 1987, Albany Medical College in Albany, New York in 1989 and State University of New York at Buffalo in Buffalo, New York in 1993. She was Board Certified by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology and licensed in both New York and Georgia. Dr. Garrison practiced in New York until 1998 when she relocated to Georgia and began her practice with Atlanta Womens Specialists. She also practiced with the Southeast Permanente Medical Group (TSPMG) where she served as an OBGYN physician, Chief of OBGYN, Managing Physician of the TownPark Medical Office and Associate Medical Director of Primary Care, Behavioral Health and OBGYN. Dr. Garrison is survived by her loving husband, Dr. John Hinds; son Matthew Christopher Hinds; parents, Diane Garrison and Phillip E Garrison of Woodstock; brother, David Phillip Garrison of Manasquan, NJ.
