Dudley William Garrett, Jr. age 89 of Milton passed away peacefully on April 10, 2025. Mr. Garrett was born November 14, 1935 to Dudley William and Katherine Marie Garrett in Atlanta. He graduated from Bass High School in Atlanta and went on to graduate from Georgia State University in 1959. He graduated in 1967 from Atlanta Law School. Mr. Garrett was a member of Kappa Sigma Chi. He served as a Captain Artillery in the US Army. Mr. Garrett was an Assistant Solicitor with the Fulton County DA, a Magistrate Judge, a member of the American Bar Association and the founder of the North Fulton Bar Association. Mr. Garrett was a longtime member of First Baptist Church of Alpharetta. He was preceded in death by his parents, Dudley William Garrett, Sr. and Katherine Marie Garrett. 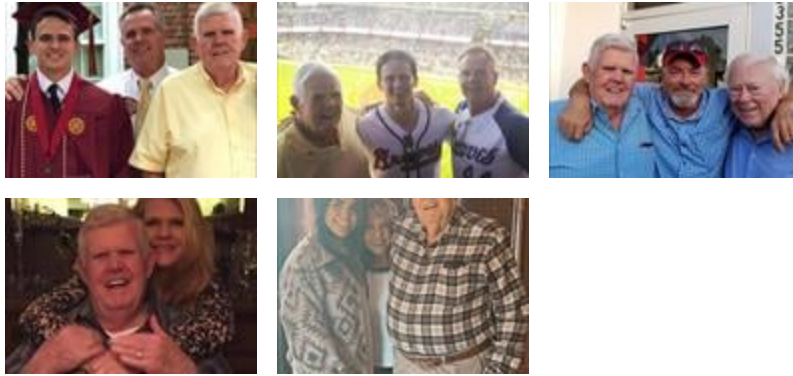
