



Mr. Earl Marcus Neve

May 16, 1939 - June 17, 2017

Earl Marcus Neve, age 78, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on June 17, 2017 after a four year battle with cancer. He was a devoted husband, father and above all, a Christ-follower. Because of his faith in God, he lived a life of service at home, in the workplace and at North Atlanta Church of Christ where he was a active member for 35 years. He touched many lives in Atlanta and beyond.

Earl began his life in Brady, Texas. Always a music lover, he sang at church and played trombone in the Brady High School marching band. He went on to earn an engineering degree from University of Texas at Arlington. After graduation, he heard that there were engineering jobs in Alabama, so he just took off and drove there. Always a faithful Christian, he stopped to attend a Wednesday night service at a local Church of Christ where he was encouraged to go to Huntsville. God was definitely directing his steps, because he not only found a job, but also met Linda at Huntsville Church of Christ!

Earl went on to earn a Master's Degree in Electrical Engineering. In 1975, he began his 35 year career at the Federal Aviation Administration in Air Traffic Operations Enroute Engineering Services. As a Senior Electrical Engineer, he was responsible for engineering design and construction of facilities used in air navigation and air traffic control. He was well known as a technical expert

in lightning protection and instrumental in modernization of the department. In addition to his technical expertise, he was greatly respected by his colleagues for his ability to patiently mentor young engineers.

His ability to encourage and connect with others not only assisted him in his career, but also helped on his mission trips. In the early 90's, Earl became inspired to share the love of Christ with the Russian people. He went on several trips with the North Atlanta family.

He was also involved in the Anchor ministry and enjoyed acting in the Christmas plays at North Atlanta. His love of music continued throughout his life. He loved singing and playing the guitar in his spare time.

Earl is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Linda, his daughter, Kelly Wiener (Brian Wiener) and granddaughter, Makayla.
