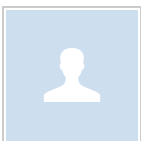

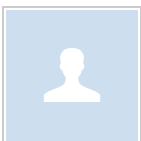
“ Brian, Yoko and Family,

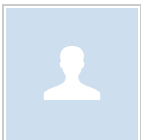
