MOORE – Mr. Edward M. Moore, 68 of North Carolina, formerly of Roswell, went to be with the Lord after a brief illness with cancer on June 2, 2007. Mr. Moore graduated from high school in Shreveport, LA and then graduated from the American Institute of Baking. Mr. Moore worked in the baking industry from the age of 17 and was a 48 year member of the American Institute of Baking. He owned and operated his own business for 32 years. He was a U. S. Army veteran, a member of Lebanon Baptist Church for 30 years and since moving to North Carolina a member of Highlands First Baptist Church. He was preceded in death by a son, Freddie James Morris and his parents, Charles and Lena Moore.
