MASTERSON – Mr. Edward P. Masterson, 88 of Alpharetta, GA, formerly of Louisville, KY, died April 4, 2009. Born in Kansas City, Kansas, Mr. Masterson was a veteran of World War II, having served in the U. S. Army Air Corps. He was retired from the Veterans Administration Office in Louisville after 38 years of service and a parishioner of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church.
