In his medically frail body, Eli always exudes grace that no one would even imagine that he is battling a very terrible syndrome that could give him so much pain and discomfort. Confined in his wheel chair and non verbal, He

was always, calm, quiet, composed and mindful to the people around him. He is an amazing warrior child even until he held God's loving hand to his eternal place in heaven.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 10:30 AM Friday, February 14th 2020 at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church. A meal of condolence will be served at the church following the service. The family will receive friends on Thursday, February 13th from 4 to 8 PM at Northside Chapel Funeral Directors. 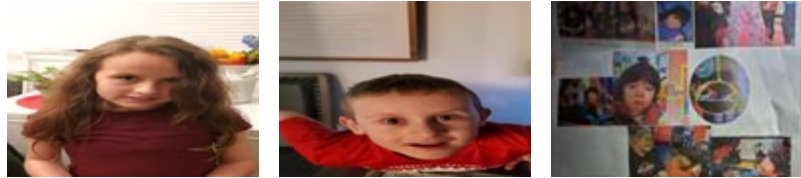

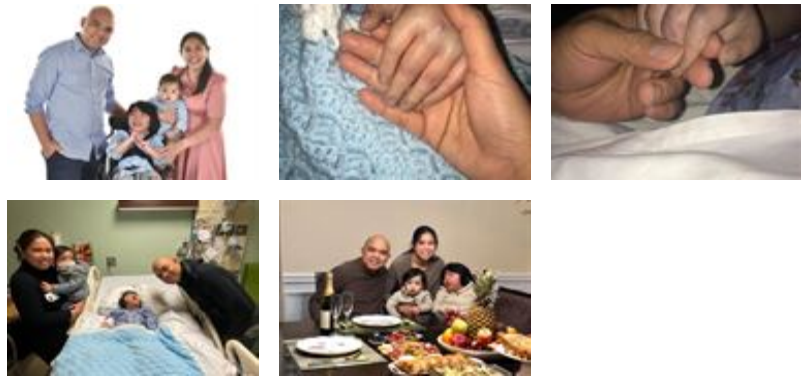
