Elliot Barrett Spix, born July 18, 1990, passed away unexpectedly May 23, 2015 from a heart attack. He graduated in 2008 from Roswell High School and was a member of the RHS Marching Band. He was a lifelong Boy Scout and with the scouts he traveled to the Arctic Circle and walked the Appalachian Trail. Elliot attended Georgia Southern University and was completing his Mechanical Engineering Degree with a minor in Electrical Engineering program at Kennesaw State University, while working full time as an Assistant Manager at Game Stop. He was very proud to have made the Dean's list at the end of this past semester. Elliot raised, trained, showed and loved his Border Collies, Finnegan and Kiefer. He is survived by his parents Brian K. Spix and Nancy S.
