August 9, 1924 - December 25, 2014

Elmer Cranor, 90, passed away peacefully on Thursday, December 25, 2014 at his home in Alpharetta. He was born August 9, 1924 in Altoona, Kansas to George and Emma (Kuntz) Cranor, where he was raised on a farm. He served in the Army during both WWII and the Korean War and was a recipient of a Purple Heart award. He worked as a business administrator for Sinclair Oil and Colonial Pipeline for a combined 40 years and was part of the pioneering team that formed and built Colonial pipeline in the early 1960's. He and his family moved to Roswell in 1976 where he was a long time member of Roswell United Methodist Church and sang in the choir for many years. His hobbies included landscaping, carpentry, and traveling. Elmer was preceded in death by his wife of 61 years, Norma; brother, Forrest; and sister, Helen. He is survived by his daughter, Kay Collins and husband Jeff of Cheyenne, Wyoming; son Kent Cranor and wife Robyn of Alpharetta, Georgia; son, Kurt Cranor and his wife Andrea of Cary, North Carolina; grandchildren Mandi Bush and husband George of Cheyenne, Kelley, Emma, Natalie, and Nathan of Alpharetta, and Anna, Andrew, and Caroline of Cary; and great grandchildren Brenden and Kyla of Cheyenne.
