Floyce Johnson Ros, of Opp, Alabama and Gulfport, died Tuesday, November 22nd, at the age of 79.

Floyce earned her Bachelor's degree from the University of Montevallo and her Master's degree from the University of Southern Mississippi and taught English and literature her entire career. She taught at Gulfport East and Gulfport High Schools, as well as Central Junior High, and for the Picayune and Jackson Public School Districts. She attended both St John and St Joseph Catholic churches in Gulfport, where she was an organist and member of the choir for many years. She relocated to Birmingham in 2006 and to Alpharetta, Georgia in 2010.

Floyce's beloved husband of 51 years, Cleve Ros, passed away September 12th of this year. She is survived by her son Dan and daughter-in-law Nickie, son Chuck and daughter-in-law Lori, and grandchildren Darrah and Catie.
