It is with great sadness our family announces the passing of Frank Bert Thomas II of Alpharetta, Georgia at the age of 80.

“Frank B.” was born to Carroll Saunders Thomas and Carye Adelene Turley Thomas on September 23, 1936 in New Orleans, Louisiana. He was a graduate of Chamberlain Hunt Military Academy in Port Gibson, Mississippi. He proudly served his country as a United States Marine in the 3rd Division. He was a licensed funeral director for Thomas Funeral Homes, Inc, in Hammond, Louisiana (the fourth generation of the Thomas family serving in the funeral business since 1880).

After retiring as President of Thomas Funeral Homes, Frank and Kathy enjoyed traveling then residing in Cody, Wyoming (with Buffalo Bill's grandson), the old Gottschalk Farm in Ponchatoula, Louisiana, the mountains of North Carolina, and settling in Alpharetta, Georgia.
